01 | READ

Open the complete passage and its neighbors before using the page.

02 | SEE

Name the people, place, movement, context, and visual interpretation.

03 | PREPARE

Build one responsible ministry move for the actual people in the room.

04 | CARRY

Leave with an action, prayer, conversation, or teaching handoff.

MINISTRY GUARDRAIL

Keep Scripture, historical context, inherited tradition, visual interpretation, and present-day application clearly distinguished. Use every page to return people to the complete KJV passage.

Begin with the Word, not the worksheet.

Deuteronomy 6:4-9

Teach the Word through the ordinary rhythms of home and community.

Psalms 78:1-8

Tell the next generation the works of God with truth and responsibility.

Nehemiah 8:1-12

Read distinctly, give the sense, and help the people understand.

2 Timothy 1:3-7

Receive sincere faith, stir up the gift, and carry it forward.

DISCUSS

Name one prayer, action, teaching move, or follow-through step that makes honor church mothers and fathers concrete.
