Leave with an action, prayer, conversation, or teaching handoff.

Keep Scripture, historical context, inherited tradition, visual interpretation, and present-day application clearly distinguished. Use every page to return people to the complete KJV passage.

Begin with the Word, not the worksheet.

Place Scripture inside the household's everyday movement.

Join household commitment to memory, witness, and concrete practice.
